

Calculating Your Costs

There are two different rates for Early College students taking classes through Northeast Community College. If the class is considered Dual Credit, meaning a college credit course taught only to high school students for which students can earn both college and high school credit, it qualifies for a reduced rate of \$49.00 per credit hour. If the student registers for a college credit only class that is available for both Early College and college students, the regular rate of \$122.00 per credit hour is applied.

Dual Credit classes could include the following:

- Classes taught in the high school, during the school day, by the high school teacher.
- Online classes taught by dually certified instructors from Northeast and taught for Early College (high school) students only.
- Classes taught by dually certified instructors before, during, or after the regular school hours for Early College students only.
- Fridays @ Northeast classes.

College credit only classes could include the following:

- Classes taken online that include both Early College and college students.
- Classes taken at the Norfolk Campus or at any of the Northeast Extended Campus locations.

Payment Options

Arrangements for payment of tuition and fees may be made in several ways. Start payment planning several days before the Early College form is due. Some options require extra time.

Payment by Nelnet Campus Commerce Payment Plan

Northeast Community College offers Nelnet Campus Commerce as a convenient budget plan. Payment(s) are processed on the 5th of each month and will continue until the balance is paid in full. Payment methods include automatic bank payments (ACH) or a credit card/debit card account. The cost to participate is a \$25 nonrefundable enrollment fee per semester which is deducted from your account by Nelnet Campus Commerce. There are no interest or finance charges and a credit check is not required. REMINDERS

- Drop Course Instructions: To drop a course, please contact Makala at (402) 844-7118. Without official notification, you will remain enrolled in the class and be held responsible for payment. A final grade will be assigned and recorded on your Northeast transcript.
- Basic Nurse Aide Course Note: An additional \$45 fee will be required if students choose to register to take the Certified Nursing Assistant exam at the end of the Basic Nurse Aide course. This \$45 fee will be required at the time of the non-credit exam registration.
- If registration occurs prior to the start of the term, payment must be made by the start of the term. If registration occurs after the term begins, payment is due upon registration.
- Students with a documented disability may be eligible for certain accommodations that support their success in the classroom.
