Disclaimer:

The following consolidated statements of financial condition and operations are unaudited and no auditor has opined that these unaudited financial statements present fairly, in all material aspects, the financial position and the results of the operations of the College for the periods reported in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles.

Definitions:

These are meant to define the uses of the various fund types within this report.

General – Funds available for general operating purposes expendable in the short term for the primary mission of the institution. Uses include personnel, operating expenses, supplies, travel and equipment.

Auxiliary – Provide a service to students, faculty, or staff and charge a fee directly related to the cost of the services; managed as essentially self-supporting, e.g. Residence Halls, Food Service, Bookstore, etc.

Restricted - Resources which have externally imposed limitations, e.g. grants and scholarships.

Plant – Resources available to acquire, replace or renew long-lived capital assets such as land, buildings, or retirement of debt.

Agency – Funds held in custody for others, e.g. student clubs and organizations.

These are meant to define the uses of the various program types within this report.

Instruction - Includes all activities that are part of an institution's instructional program.

Academic Support - Includes support services for the institution's primary missions: instruction, research, and public service. (ex. Libraries, Academic Administration, Center for Enterprise)

Student Services - Includes those activities whose primary purpose is to contribute to the student's emotional and physical well-being and to his or her intellectual, cultural, and social development outside the context of the formal instructional program. (ex. Athletics, Financial Aid, Counseling, Disability Services)

Institutional Support - Includes 1) central executive-level activities concerned with management and long-range planning of the entire institution. (ex. Executive Management, Fiscal Operations, General Administrative and Logistical Services, Administrative Computing Services, Public Relations/Development, Registrar)

Operation and Maintenance of Plant - Includes the operation and maintenance of physical plants for all institutional activities. (ex. Physical Plant Administration, Building Maintenance, Custodial Services, Safety, Security, Utilities, Landscape and Grounds, Major Repairs and Renovation)



Treatment of Students

The President shall not cause or allow conditions, procedures or decisions related to the treatment of students that are unsafe, unfair, disrespectful, or unnecessarily intrusive.

Further, without limiting the scope of the above statement by the following list, the President shall not:

- 1. Permit students and others who use College property to be without reasonable protections against hazards or conditions that might threaten their health, safety or well-being.
 - Allow students to be without current, enforced procedures that minimize the

 provide methods for dealing with individuals who harass.
- 2. Deliver programs in a manner that is insensitive to students' culture.
- 3. Permit violation of student confidentiality and privacy, except where specific disclosure is required by legislation or regulation.
 - 1. Use forms or procedures that elicit information for which there is no clear necessity.
 - 2. Use methods of collecting, reviewing, storing or transmitting student information that inadequately protect against improper access to personal information.
- 4. Permit admission, registration, evaluation, or recognition processes that treat students unfairly.
- 5. Permit unfair, inconsistent or untimely handling of student complaints.
 - 1. Permit students to be without a process for registering a complaint or concern, including an appeal process, or to be uninformed of the process.

- 2. Retaliate against any student for non-disruptive expression of dissent.
- 6. Permit students to be uninformed of student rights and responsibilities, including expectations for student behavior, and the consequences of failure to adhere to the expectations.
- 7. Permit decisions affecting students to be taken without appropriate consultation with students.

Freedom of Speech

1. Procedure Summary Statement

The College honors the First Amendment of the U.S. Constitution and is committed to freedom of expression and the free exchange of ideas. The purpose of this procedure is to articulate, clarify and underscore that commitment in a manner that furthers both freedom of expression and the College's mission, vision and values.

2. Definitions

- 1. "Freedom of speech" and "freedom of expression" refer to one's Constitutional right to articulate and express ideas and opinions, through any means, i.e. speaking, writing, or artistic expression, without fear of government retaliation, censorship, or other sanction. The College is a public institution of higher education, which values this right, and consider this right to be indispensable to its ability to transmit knowledge and fundamental to the College community's pursuit to discover, explore, interpret, and question knowledge and opinions. The College greatly values the creation and maintenance of an inclusive climate in which all members of its community are welcomed and are encouraged to participate in the free expression of ideas. Because the search for new truths often comes forth only after bringing together differing opinions, the College aims to foster and uphold the capacity of the College community to engage in discourse and deliberation in an effective, responsible, and respectful manner. This is critical to the College's mission.
- "Members of the College Community" refers to students and employees of the College, the Board of Governors, as well as guests of the College and members of the general public lawfully present on College premises.
- "Designated Public Forums" are places the College designates as open for expressive applications to all or part of the campus community, or the community at large. This might be a mall, a plaza or the sidewalks. Reasonable time, place and manner restrictions may be

implemented in a viewpoint or content-neutral application.

- 4. "Limited Public Forums" are places (such as a concert hall), events (such as a student panel discussion), or other avenues for expression (such as an electronic bulletin board), which can be designated for use by a particular group and limited to particular topics or types of speech, as long as the limitations are reasonable and viewpoint-neutral.
- 5. "Non-Public Forums" are all places and resources not otherwise categorized as Designated Public Forums and Limited Public Forums.

3. Procedure

1. General

- 1. As a corollary to the College's commitment to protect and promote free expression, members of the College community are expected and required to act in conformity with the underlying principles of free expression. Although members of the College community are free to comment on, criticize and contest views that others express, they must do so at a time and place, and in a manner that does not prevent, impede, or obstruct the freedom of others to also exercise their rights to express themselves. With this policy, the College is not only promoting a lively and fearless freedom of debate and deliberation, but also protecting that freedom when others attempt to restrict it. It is a careful, deliberative and nuanced balance of interests that the College must strike in order to protect this important right.
- 2. The First Amendment provides no guarantee of civility. However, as a community of educators and learners, the College places a high value on civil discourse and respect for one another. The College has an obligation to protect the dignity and security of all members of its community from those who would seek to use speech primarily to deprive others of their freedom to learn, their freedom to contribute and their freedom to participate fully in the College's mission. Therefore, the College encourages all within its community its Board, administration, faculty and staff, students, alumni, and all who act as its ambassadors to serve as models reflecting behavior consistent with the tenets of civil discourse.
- 3. As important as are the rights to debate and discuss competing ideas, the First Amendment does not protect all expression. The College will not facilitate expression in violation of the law or that poses an unreasonable threat to the safety of the College community or to the College's ability to fulfill its mission. Certain kinds of expression, including, but not limited to: speech that incites violence, fighting words, speech that defames or defrauds, speech that constitutes a genuine threat, or unlawfully discriminates, or speech that unlawfully invades privacy, is not protected speech. Acts or conduct which threaten the safety of persons or property are not protected by the Constitution or the College.
- 4. Individuals, once provided the requisite due process, found in violation of the provisions contained in this Procedure, shall be subject to review and potential discipline in accordance with Board Policy, any applicable administrative or disciplinary procedure of the College, or any other applicable rule, regulation, code of conduct or other policy corresponding to such individuals' relationship to the College community (e.g. student, faculty and staff).

5. While the principles of Academic Freedom are unique ideals possessed by the teaching profession, separate from an individual's First Amendment Rights, the College is clear in its commitment and faithful to the preservation of Academic Freedom. This policy is not intended to interfere with or encumber those principles.

2. Guide for Property Use

- 1. College resources, for example, its land and buildings, its library collections, its computer networks and equipment, are to be applied first and foremost to its mission of teaching and learning, and therefore, such College properties are primarily dedicated to this mission, which encompasses all academic activities, student life, intercollegiate athletics, and the administrative functions that support this mission. These properties are not generally open and available to the public—they are provided to and by the College, in order that it might carry out its educational charge. The First Amendment does not mandate that the College grant the public unfettered access to its facilities. The College may elect to open certain spaces to the public without limitations, to open other spaces with limitations on use, and to maintain the non-public status of other spaces.
- 2. All users of College property assume responsibility to comply with all applicable laws, regulations, policies and procedures and assume responsibility for fees and charges applicable to associated events and activities. All persons on College property are required to comply with the instructions of a properly identified College official, representative or agent. Persons engaging in actions that do not comply with applicable laws, regulations, or policies shall be subject to disciplinary measures, including separation from the College, and also to charges of violation of the law.
- 3. An individual may not materially disrupt activities conducted within the context of the College's mission. The College may reasonably regulate the time, place, and manner of expression, in accordance with the law, in order to ensure that the ordinary activities of the College are not disrupted. Such regulations must be narrowly tailored to serve significant, viewpoint-neutral interests, and cannot substantially burden more speech than necessary to protect the College's interest.
- 4. Spaces such as classrooms and labs where teaching takes place; or offices where administrative business is carried out, are not freely open to the public. There are, however, spaces within the College that may be opened to both members of the College community and the public for a variety of purposes, including speech and expression. The College may implement rules and processes grounded in law and other College policies and procedures, to designate which properties, facilities, and/or other College resources, in whole or in part, are categorized under law as Designated Public Forums, Limited Public Forums or Non-Public Forums.
- Proposed uses of designated forums will differ on a case-by-case basis and may
 evolve over time to meet the needs of its mission and the community. The College
 will not implement rules or processes which differentiate use of properties or
 resources, or disciplinary outcomes, based upon the viewpoint of the user.
- 3. Related Procedures Other policies and procedures may provide for other more specific reasonable time, place and manner restrictions on freedom of expression and freedom of speech. This procedure should be read in conjunction with those related procedures, which

1. Northeast Community College shall establish Residency Guidelines and Procedures for determining a student's residency status. These guidelines and procedures will be established as an administrative procedure and made available in the College Catalog.

1. PROCEDURE SUMMARY STATEMENT @

To establish guidelines for determining student residency.

2. DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this procedure, the following definitions shall apply:

- 1. Nebraska Resident Tuition the Nebraska resident tuition rate set by the Board of Governors applicable to the academic program in which an individual intends to enroll.
- 2. Bordering State Resident Tuition the bordering state (Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, South Dakota and Wyoming) resident tuition rate set by the Board of Governors applicable to the academic program in which an individual intends to enroll.
- 3. Nonresident Tuition the nonresident tuition rate set by the Board of Governors applicable to the academic program in which an individual intends to enroll.
- 4. Legal Age the age of majority (age 19) set by Nebraska state statute.
- 5. Minor individuals who have not reached the age of majority.
- 6. Emancipated Minor an individual who by virtue of marriage, financial status, or for other reasons has become independent of his or her parents or guardians.
- 7. Established a Home (phrase) an individual who is habitually present for a minimum period of one hundred eight days in Nebraska or a bordering state immediately prior to applying for resident status with the bona fide intention of making Nebraska or such bordering state his or her permanent residence. On-campus housing cannot be considered as a domicile or permanent residence for establishing residency.
- 8. Lawful Permanent Resident an individual who is not a U.S. citizen who has been lawfully accorded the privilege of residing permanently in the United States as an immigrant in accordance with immigration laws.

3. PROCEDURE

- 1. Requirements for Residency
 - 1. An individual will qualify as a resident of the State of Nebraska or bordering states for tuition purposes at Northeast Community College if they meet the standards set in any one of the following categories. Documented proof is required (See section 2.2).
 - 1. A person of legal age or an emancipated minor who has established a home in Nebraska or a bordering state.

- 2. A minor whose parent(s) or guardian has established a home in Nebraska or a bordering state. If a student has matriculated in any state postsecondary educational institution while their parent(s) or guardian(s) had an established home in this state and the parent(s) or gaurdian(s) ceases to reside in the state, the student will maintain their residency status.
- 3. A person of legal age and a dependent, for federal income tax purposes, of parent(s) or guardian who has established a home in Nebraska or a bordering state.
- 4. An individual who is married to a person who has established a home in Nebraska or bordering state and who has proof of residence in Nebraska or a bordering state. (A copy of the marriage certificate must be provided in addition to documentation requirements in section 3.2)
- 5. Lawful permanent residents or individuals who have been granted asylum or refugee status and who have established a home in Nebraska or a bordering state.
- 6. An individual who is a staff member or dependent of a staff member at the College.
- An individual on active duty with the armed services of the United States and has been assigned a permanent duty station in Nebraska, or a dependent or spouse of such individual.
- 8. An individual who has served a period of not fewer than ninety (90) days in the active United States military and has been discharged within three (3) years of the initial enrollment date at the College, or the spouse or dependent of such individual, or an individual using military educational benefits under the Post 9/11 or Montgomery GI Bill[®].
- 9. A student currently serving in the Nebraska National Guard.
- 10. A person who is qualified for a national service educational award or summer of service award from the National Service Trust of the United States.
- 11. For Nebraska resident tuition rate only: An individual who is a graduate of an accredited Nebraska high school and who meets the requirements of Nebraska law found in Neb. Rev. Stat. §85-502(9) or an individual who has previously been enrolled at the College as a Nebraska resident student.

2. Documentation

- 1. Individuals identified in sections 1.1.1 through 1.1.5 must provide at least three (3) of the following items. All documents must be dated at least one hundred eighty days prior to the first day of classes and must reflect the individual's name.
 - 1. Record of Nebraska or bordering state voter registration;
 - 2. Nebraska or bordering state income tax return for the most recent year;
 - 3. Nebraska or bordering state driver's license;
 - Nebraska or bordering state vehicle registration;
 - 5. Evidence of ownership of Nebraska or bordering state property;
 - 6. Nebraska or bordering state housing rental agreement;

- 7. Nebraska or bordering state insurance policy;
- 8. Evidence that parent(s) as Nebraska or bordering state resident(s) claim(s) the student as a dependent; or
- 9. Other documentation as approved by the Registrar.

3. Application

- Any student who has been classified as a nonresident for tuition purposes and believes that he or she may qualify as a Nebraska or bordering state resident must file a Request for Nebraska or Bordering State Residency Status form with the Registrar by the first day of the term for which the tuition fee was charged.
- 2. The Request for Nebraska or Bordering State Residency Status form, as well as further information regarding residency classification, is available from the Admissions & Registration Office.
- 3. It is the student's responsibility to initiate a change in residency status.

4. Appeals

 An individual who believes that he or she has been incorrectly denied a Nebraska or bordering state residency determination may appeal the decision through the Vice President of Student Services.

1. A follow-up discussion was held regarding the roundtable meeting held at West Point. There is work that Charlene will need to follow up on.

There is much speculation in the comments from the West Point roundtable meeting, and it appears that there are misunderstandings and a lack of knowledge in some of the high schools regarding the termination of payments to the high schools for teachers teaching dual enrollment classes. The dual credit topic needs reaffirmed with teachers, administrators, and parents. It may also be a good idea to provide more information to parents so that they are aware of what dual enrollment courses are offered. There will be a push for funding for free dual enrollment across the state.

The needs are different in O'Neill, South Sioux City, West Point and Norfolk. A grant request is being developed to hire someone (career navigator) to meet with/at the high schools throughout the service area. This is about changing the college going culture and getting students into the programs that they are passionate about. If funded, the foundation will help fund the position for five years but eventually Northeast would have to find a way to sustain the position. Part of the planning grant is understanding what the needs are in the high schools.

How do we fill the gaps in the communities in which we don't have an extended campus? (Laurel, Allen, Bloomfield, Neligh, Plainview, Osmond, Crofton, etc.) Future conversations will be about possibly piggy backing with other meetings of the ESUs that are occurring in different areas. Charlene advised that Northeast already hosts meetings with superintendents, principals, counselors, and ESUs. This meeting would provide the Ownership Linkage Committee with another opportunity to meet with constituents to gain

a better understanding of what is happening in other regions of the service area. Will be great to connect/link with community members on an annual basis.

Counselors aren't always filling the counselor role as their plates are full of additional responsibilities. With Northeast working to have a career navigator, we could possibly help fill some of the gap of a counselor in the schools.

2. South Sioux City – June 12th. Educators and community leaders will be invited to view and discuss information from the gap analysis for the tri-state area (Siouxland region). Good, evaluated information on position openings in the region, upcoming jobs, needs of the region, wage analysis, etc. will be presented and discussion will be held on how Northeast might fill the gaps. Following the presentation, there will be an opportunity to break into small groups and have additional conversations around the data. (20-minute presentation; hour breakout sessions)

A gap analysis was conducted of the entire service area. The data, over time, will be shared with the Board of Governors as they look at program development.

- 3. Charlene and her team have had regular conversations throughout the year with their colleagues in Ainsworth. Northeast wants to meet in Ainsworth again in August to discuss how do we really assure that we can attract students as Northeast continues to plan to offer a nursing course in Ainsworth. The Ownership Linkage Committee will plan a meeting with constituents in conjunction with this meeting, followed by a reception.
- 4. Courtney Wittstruck, NCCA Executive Director, has requested the community colleges to do work prior to the August NCCA Board of Directors meeting. Dr. Barrett feels that this should be done at the Ownership Linkage Committee level. Nicole and Pat will attend the NCCA meeting in August and discuss this information with the other representatives.

A one-hour meeting will be scheduled (late June or early July) to review information and identify people who may be influencers in our area that may also be advocates for Northeast. A one-hour meeting will be scheduled (late June or July) for this review. Del, Pat, and Nicole are encouraged to reach out to one other board meeting to discuss the prework.



Monitoring Report EL-03 Treatment of Employees June 12, 2024

I hereby present my monitoring report on the Executive Limitations Policy EL-03: Treatment of Employees according to monitoring report schedule (BPD-04). I certify that the information contained in this report is true and represents compliance with a reasonable interpretation of all aspects of the policy unless specifically stated otherwise.

The President shall not cause or allow a workplace environment that is unfair, disrespectful, unsafe, disorganized, or otherwise interferes with employees' ability to do their jobs.

INTERPRETATION

1. Whether a person is being treated fairly or with respect, or whether a person feels organized, is a matter of perception, so asking employees in surveys is a reasonable way to assess it. Northeast Community College administered an Engagement Survey in the Fall of 2023. The results provide a benchmark score for each driver. Therefore, I interpret a workplace environment that is not unfair, disrespectful, unsafe, disorganized, or otherwise interferes with employees' ability to do their jobs that has a Inclusion Driver and Employee Empowerment scores at or above the benchmark score for higher education institutions that work with our consultant, McLean & Company. Furthermore, the Title IX Climate Survey administered in the Spring of 2024 allowing employees to rate their perceptions of working conditions. A reasonable benchmark of 75% aligns

with the national average for similar institutions. An expectation of 100% on a survey would not be reasonable because surveys measure perception, not fact.

- a. <u>Not unfair</u> to mean a benchmark score or higher on the Engagement Survey 75% positive response or higher on the Title IX Climate Survey to the question: "I believe this school is trying hard to make sure that all students and employees are treated equally and fairly."
- b. Not disrespectful to mean a 75% positive response or higher on the employee climate survey to the question: "I believe that students and employees at this school respect one another."
- c. <u>Not unsafe</u> to mean a 75% positive response or higher on the employee climate survey to the question: "I believe the school is trying hard to make sure that all students and employees are safe."
- 2. Additionally, several studies have found a correlation between the use of sick leave and stressful working conditions https://www.thehrdirector.com/business-news/health-and-wellbeing/stress-biggest-cause-of-absenteeism/ and https://www.rcinet.ca/en/2015/10/05/workplace-stress-means-employees-take-more-sick-days-off/. Therefore, I interpret a workplace environment that is not unsafe to mean the average sick leave per person is below average for our industry. 



The results from the survey are very positive. The Engagement Survey is in its first year of administration and we look forward to continuous improvement. For the Title IX Survey the results are all higher than the previous survey. The College is committed to addressing areas of concern. We will continue to invest in bettering the culture working with McLean & Company, our Engagement Team and utilizing focus groups as an additional channel to attain employee feedback outside of the engagement and climate surveys. This includes meetings at the extended campuses to understand their engagement needs.

D. The College's average annual sick leave taken per person per year is 2.00 days, down from 2.85 last year, less than the industry average.

... the President shall not:

1. Allow employees, or those seeking to be employees, to be without current, enforced, written human resource procedures that clarify expectations and working conditions provide for effective handling of grievances, and protect against wrongful conditions.

Accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission was notified of reaffirmation in Feb 2024.

...the President shall not:

1.1 Permit Employees to be without adequate protection from harassment and bias.

INTERPRETATION

I interpret <u>adequate protection</u> from harassment and bias to mean the organization has policies and procedures in place to address harassing conduct and hold employees accountable at the earliest possible stage before the conduct becomes so "severe and pervasive, and/or objectively offensive."

AP-1010.0 Nondiscrimination

AP-1010.1 Harassment

This is reasonable because inadequate protection from harassment and bias for employees could result in severe consequences it can have for the victims and those who witness it. Additionally, workplace harassment and/or bias can have a direct effect on the College in terms of increased absenteeism, lower productivity, higher employee turnover, loss of morale, and the potential costs of fighting or settling harassment lawsuits.

Furthermore, survey results from both the 2023 Engagement Survey and 2024 Title IX Climate Survey are indicators of the employee's perception of their working environment.

EVIDENCE

- A. Internal review of applicable policies and procedures confirmed they are consistent with all legal requirements. (see section #1). Nondiscrimination went through formal review in March of 2024 and Harassment went through in May of 2021.
- B. Internal review of applicable policies and procedures confirmed they include descriptions of unacceptable circumstances and a detailed reporting process. (see section #1)
- C. Internal review of policies and procedures confirmed a process to submit a complaint other than to an immediate supervisor is present. See section F.

- D. A review by VP-HR of HR files on harassment confirmed there was one report (Year 2023) of harassment that after the investigation commenced, the complainant chose to withdraw the complaint for informal resolution. Professional development was completed by the accused. In the event there are any substantiated claims, the appropriate discipline is

applied by VP-HR or designee, which is consistent with the progressive discipline procedures AP-7322.0 Progressive Discipline for Non-Faculty Employees and AP-7322.1 Progressive Discipline for Faculty Employees.



- F. Maxient Software is utilized for managing student and employee misconduct, harassment, or discrimination reports . This tool provides an effective, efficient process when responding to reports. There is increased awareness of prohibited forms of conduct and information about how to use the College's reporting system.
- G. Annual harassment prevention and Title IX training is administered to all employees through the Learning Management System, SafeColleges. All safety (SafeColleges), information security (SANS) and Title IX training is launched in October of each calendar year and employees have 1 month to complete all required, virtual compliance annual training. All training is 100 percent complete. If training is not completed as scheduled, a warning is provided to the employees notifying them that computer access will be suspended. All new hires are provided with 30 days to complete the training.
- H. The Title IX survey for employees was administered once again in the spring of 2024. The survey is administered every two years. This survey is a necessary component of the annual State of Nebraska Legislative Report for Title IX subject to §85-608. The last report was submitted in the fall of 2023 (link below). Per state statute, this report is required for odd-numbered years.

...the President shall not:

1.2 Permit employees to be uninformed of the performance standards by which they will be assessed.

INTERPRETATION

Compliance will be demonstrated through the performance management program where employees create their own annual performance goals that include frequent discussions, ambitious scope, specific milestones, and transparency. Employee performance expectations for the coming year include 1) department goals, 2) professional development goals, and 3) performance goals. This is reasonable because according to the American National Standards Institute, Inc., departmental, behavioral, and performance goals which are specific and measurable "describes the minimum effective standard for performance goal setting".

EVIDENCE

An internal review of goal submissions was at 99% for all permanent employees as of December 1, 2022. Employees will be evaluated at the end of the fiscal or academic year for their goal progress and completion, overall work performance, behavior, and individual professional development accomplishments.

Staff performance evaluations are conducted through PeopleAdmin, which is the software tool Human Resources uses for talent and record management. This tool also supports recruiting, hiring, and job descriptions. The evaluation process consists of steps taken throughout the year by both the employee and their supervisor. In addition to the performance evaluation, there is a "Mid-Year Coaching Check-in". The evaluations are used as a coaching opportunity, and the College encourages supervisors to have regular communication with their staff and faculty throughout the year. Having a mid-year check-in, and regular communication will allow the supervisor to coach, guide, and direct their employees in a positive manner.

Faculty evaluations have a slightly different process. The Vice President of Education Services (VP-ES) in collaboration with the VP-HR and VP-AS has established standardized responsibilities included in the standard 15% essential function portion "general additional duties beyond teaching." Specific additional duties may vary as they are determined in collaboration with the VP-ES, appropriate dean, and individual faculty member to fit the instructor and benefit the institution. All faculty credentials were reviewed in summer 2023 to ensure faculty are appropriately credentialed for the courses they teach. In addition, faculty performance evaluations now include a credential review by the Academic Dean or Academic Program Director to cross-reference the courses being taught by the instructor to ensure appropriate credentialing. In summer 2024, the VP-ES will develop a credential to subject crosswalk matching standards established by the Higher Learning Commission for all programs offered at Northeast. The crosswalk will be a valuable resource to ensure consistency and appropriate credentials when hiring new faculty and during faculty evaluation review.

AP-7315.0 Employee Performance Review procedure was revised May 2023 to reflect the new process going forward.

...the President shall not:

2. Allow conditions or practices inconsistent with a trusting, cooperative, and collaborative workplace environment.

INTERPRETATION

Asking employees for their perceptions anonymously is most likely to provide a valid response. 75% is reasonable or at an industry benchmark because if a person disagrees with something, there may be a tendency to criticize the workplace environment even though there is trust, cooperation, and collaboration. Two questions from the Title IX Survey seem to be most appropriate to describe a trusting, cooperative and collaborative work place: "I feel like I am a part of this school." and "I am happy to be an employee at this school." In the Engagement survey questions related to departmental collaboration will provide the best evidence for creating these conditions.

EVIDENCE

statement, "I feel like I am a part of this school." And 92% responded positively to the statement, "I am happy to be an employee at this On the most recent employee survey conducted in the Spring of 2024, an average of 90% of respondents replied positively to the school." In reference to the Engagement Survey Department Collaboration Driver, the overall score is above the benchmark, there is a need to improve the working relationships and communication between departments.



The evidence of this data point is influenced by the work of the Human Resources and the Engagement Team.

The Engagement team has approximately twenty members to represent all divisional areas of the college. Their vision is to empower and inspire employees through active engagement with their respective divisions and departments throughout the college community. The team's purpose is to empower and inspire employees through active engagement within their respective departments and positions, through the college community.

Purpose:

- Develop an environment where employees feel motivated, appreciated, energetic, and committed to their work.
- Promote interaction and trust between administration, leadership, and employees.
- Seek to understand and appreciate different perspectives.
- · Address employee concerns and issues.
- Encourage, celebrate, and recognize employees.
- Actively solicit employee feedback; evaluate and recommend strategies for improving employee engagement.
- Review employee survey results, assess results and recommend appropriate actions to address priorities for change.

Professional Development training programs for all employees are being scoped and will be implemented during the 2024 – 2025 school year. The topics will be derived from feedback from the Engagement Survey, Engagement Survey Focus Groups and other feedback or needs assessment mechanisms.

...the President shall not:

3. Retaliate against any employee for non-disruptive expression of dissent.

INTERPRETATION

Engagement Survey results from the Inclusion Driver as noted above seem to provide an anonymous perception of their emotional safety.

It is also important to articulate employees' freedom of speech and provide opportunities for engagement in policy development and approval. Moreover, the President needs to demonstrate openness to feedback and criticism.

EVIDENCE

- As noted previously, the Engagement Survey driver related to Inclusion was above the benchmark by 3 percentage points.
- A new procedure was developed and approved related to (AP-1030.0) Freedom of Speech.
- The College developed a Governance Taskforce in the spring of 2022 to review the current shared governance structure at Northeast Community College. This included reviewing data and feedback to inform changes to move towards a more collaborative structure. In May 2024, revisions to the existing structure were approved to be launched August 2024. The revision organizes committees by function rather than hierarchy and aligns all under the strategic priorities. Northeast Community College is organized into two distinct yet interrelated structures. One is the line structure of full, direct authority and administrative responsibility. The other is the channel of communications, under which the students and staff participate through committees in the decision-making process. Both structures are utilized to ensure the continuation of active and productive input into college planning and decision making. The structure is governed by the Guidelines for Shared Governance. The Engagement Team had identified governance and decision-making as high-priority action items that were spearheaded by this Taskforce. Regular newsletter communications and informational sessions about changes related to policy and procedure management are a few examples of efforts to provide additional transparency into governance at the institution. A SharePoint site was developed in 2023 to centrally house all shared governance agendas, notes, and supporting documentation that all employees have access to. A committee membership dashboard was developed to provide further transparency into committee membership, and also provide supervisors and vice presidents with additional insight into professional development opportunities via committee membership for those employees that are seeking it.
- PolicyStat software was implemented to simplify policy/procedure management. In 2024, the College began adding protocols
 to this platform for ease of access and versioning capabilities.

Although the College provides anonymous opportunities for gathering valuable employee feedback opportunities, the VP-HR and Cabinet members welcome opportunities for open expressions of dissent to align with the organizational values of continuous quality improvement. Trust is the desired condition, and we are dedicated to improving this as articulated throughout this document. Throughout the year several "coffee and convos" were hosted by the VP for Educational Services; open houses were hosted by the president; and meetings with the employee group leaders occurred. These are opportunities where employee leadership can share concerns and celebrations in an effort to promote open communication and trust.

...the President shall not:

5. Allow employees to be unprepared to deal with emergency situations.

INTERPRETATION

I interpret employees to be not unprepared to mean:

- A. There are written emergency management procedures and protocols available to all employees, which include detailed instructions for handling threats such as fire, weather-related emergencies, security-related emergencies such as bomb threats, physical violence by a hostile person, or cyberattacks. Access to written instructions is a reasonable first step in being prepared.
- B. Annual safety and emergency-related training is administered for all employees to provide the basic background knowledge and information of necessary actions when there is an emergency, or disruption of college operations.
- C. There are fire and emergency response drills conducted on an annual schedule to conform to standards required by law. Having actual safety trainings and drills provides "practice" and adds to preparedness should a real situation occur.
- D. A 75% positive response rate on an employment survey to the question: "I believe this school is trying hard to make sure that all students and employees are safe." Asking employees for their perceptions anonymously is most likely to provide a valid response. 75% is reasonable, because if a person disagrees with something, there may be a tendency to criticize the work environment and health and safety practices.

EVIDENCE

- A. Written emergency management procedures and protocols are available to all employees on the Northeast website: https://northeast.edu/about-us/risk-and-safety-information. As protocols are revised, they are also being added to PolicyStat.
- B. Virtual safety and cybersecurity emergency training is administered twice a year to ensure employees understand and agree to campus safety and security protocols. Compliance is demonstrated if there is a 100% virtual safety and cybersecurity emergency training completion in a calendar year. In 2023, there was 100% completion of these trainings, including Title IX. These training programs are administered through SafeColleges. Users who complete their training, report a phish campaign properly, or report a security incident earn a security badge sticker to display on their laptop cover or in their office.

 There have been changes made to the compliance training annual cycle and due dates. The new process is to have all safety (SafeColleges), information security (SANS) and Title IX training be launched in October of each calendar year. Employees will have 1 month to complete all required, virtual compliance training on an annual schedule.

The College hired a Director of Risk Management and Associate Director of Environmental Health and Safety who will contribute to the success of safety and security compliance. There is an information security sub-committee that meets monthly to oversee compliance practices of this work.

A number of training programs and exercises have been conducted to build awareness and make our campus safe. A few of these are listed below:

- Sept 13. 2023—Campus Guard TTX—was with IT.
- November 20, 2023—conducted a hotwash regarding student suicide.
- January 3, 2024—Presentation on risk vulnerability assessment tool; presentation on bomb threats and overview of Building Emergency Action Plans
- January-May 2024—Commencement workgroup—created Event Action Plan that was used during commencement this year; included adding an Incident Command Post in the CAC and an active EOC in the Union on May 10th.
- Feb 9—presentation with custodial crew re. building emergency plans
- March 1—Fish Out of Water TTX with Northeast EOC staff (NEOC)
- March 4—first planning meeting for Cyber Ready board game; will be taken throughout the area and conducted in various communities
- Physical building assessments—started in March—have completed CAC, CWC, CON, Union, AAH, Acklie Farm, Ag
 Complex, Physical Plant, and the outside area by Paradise Courtyard and the picnic shelter to the north of the L
 Building. From March May on various dates; this included an environmental scan for the JED Campus, as well.
- March 27 —participated in the statewide tornado drill
- April 5 Conducted an FBI Active Shooter Training and Drill
- April 17—participated in the citywide full-scale exercise for a water plant security breach. We ran an EOC in conjunction with the city's EOC during the event. We were participants in this and did not facilitate it.
- May 7 9 Phoney Bombardment Functional Drill
- Upcoming—Quietus TTX with Residence Life, NEOC, law enforcement; scenario will be a student's death in the residence halls on June 10th.
- Working more on the Cyber Ready game to roll out in various towns across our service area. We're doing a run through with some of our staff on June 11th. Once we've done that, we're going to work on scheduling this at each of our campus locations (Norfolk, O'Neill, West Point, South Sioux City, and Ainsworth so far), and maybe some

other places that are interested, as well. We're not sure on the timeline for this, but we would hopefully have this completed before the snow flies this year.

- C. The College conducts an annual, internal fire and emergency response drill schedule per the emergency response protocols.
- D. On the most recent employee survey conducted in the Spring of 2024, 93% of respondents agreed with the statement "I believe this school is trying hard to make sure that all students and employees are safe."



Monitoring Report EL-09, Organizational Integrity June 12, 2024

I hereby present my monitoring report on the Executive Limitations Policy EL-09: Organizational Integrity according to monitoring report schedule (BPD-04). I certify that the information contained in this report is true and represents compliance with a reasonable interpretation of all aspects of the policy unless specifically stated otherwise.

The President shall not permit an organizational culture that lacks a high degree of integrity at all levels of the organization.

INTERPRETATION

Standard of Measurement: An internal benchmark is established on an employee engagement survey to questions relating to organizational integrity. In the Fall of 2023, Northeast Community College administered an Employee Engagement Survey utilizing the services of McLean & Company. Employees were asked two questions which I interpret to be related to organizational integrity: "I am not discriminated against at Northeast Community College" and "I am emotionally safe at work." Whether an organization has a high degree of integrity is at least partly a matter of perception, and asking employees is a reasonable way to assess it. Since this is the first engagement survey utilizing McLean & Company, it is reasonable to establish a benchmark and then create a future target.

Level of Achievement: Compliance will be demonstrated initially by establishing a benchmark, and compliance will be demonstrated in future years when there is indicated on the employee engagement survey a satisfaction score equal to or greater than the benchmark score to the questions "I am not discriminated against at Northeast Community College" and "I am emotionally safe at work." This is reasonable because establishing a benchmark is required to show compliance for future years, and a satisfaction score equal to or greater than the benchmark indicates that employee perception of the integrity of the organization is being maintained.

EVIDENCE

- a) Initial internal benchmark: 85% of employees responded with a level of 5 or 6 on a six-point scale the extent to which they agreed with the statement: "I am not discriminated against at Northeast Community College." The benchmark compared to other higher education institutions serviced by McLean for the responses to this question was 81%. As noted, an internal benchmark will be established for the future.
- b) Initial internal benchmark: 84% of employees responded with a level of 5 or 6 on a six-point scale the extent to which they agreed with the statement: "I am emotionally safe at work." The benchmark compared to other higher education institutions serviced by McLean for the responses to this question was 79%. As noted, an internal benchmark will be established for the future.

Further, without limiting the scope of the above statement by the following list,

... the President shall not:

1. Permit employees and others to be without a mechanism for confidential reporting of alleged or suspected improper activities without fear of retaliation.

INTERPRETATION

Standard of Measurement: I interpret the "mechanism" for confidential reporting of alleged or suspected improper activities without fear of retaliation to mean there is a written procedure in place, reviewed at least every five years, that:

- a) Clearly defines "improper activities." Clear, written guidelines explaining the circumstances that are not acceptable assist an employee in making the decision to report an activity.
- b) Specifically outlines the steps to be taken by an employee to report those activities. Knowledge of the process to follow is crucial for proper reporting.
- c) Provides for an option to report an improper activity without reporting directly to his or her immediate supervisor. It is important for an employee to be able to submit a complaint without fear of retaliation, regardless of who has committed an alleged improper activity.
- d) There are no reports of alleged or suspected improper activities that have not been addressed without appropriate discipline.

EVIDENCE

The following operational procedure provides employees with a mechanism for confidential reporting of alleged or suspected

improper activities: AP-3050.0 Fraud and Whistleblowing. Review of this procedure confirms:

- a) Improper activities are clearly defined by including descriptions of unacceptable acts or circumstances.
- b) The reporting process is clear and specifically outlined.
- c) The process includes multiple individuals to whom a report may be made, including an individual other than an employee's immediate supervisor. The procedure also includes a section which provides that retaliation against an employee who reports an improper activity is specifically prohibited. In addition, on the College website employees are provided with information for reporting suspected criminal activity (Link to Crime Reporting) and a Resource Guide with contact information for reporting any campus safety concern.
- d) All reports of fraudulent or improper acts are submitted to Human Resources for investigation and appropriate action. Review of HR files confirms there were no reports of fraudulent or improper acts during the reporting period.

...the President shall not:

2. Operate without a framework for the confidentiality, integrity and availability of employee and student data and electronic resources.

INTERPRETATION

I interpret the "framework" for confidentiality, integrity and availability of employee and student data and electronic resources to mean:

- a) There are written procedures in place, reviewed at least every five years, that address general data privacy concerns of College employees and students, as well as the specific legal requirements of applicable data privacy laws including FERPA, HIPAA, GLBA and PCI-DDS. This is reasonable because legal requirements reflect the industry norms for privacy policies.
- b) During the reporting period, no violations of any applicable data privacy law were reported to the respective government enforcement agency for which the College was responsible.

EVIDENCE

a) The following written procedures governing the use of data at the College are currently in place and were last reviewed in June, 2023, and are scheduled for next review in June, 2028:

AP-3511.0 Information Security

AP-3511.1 Acceptable Use of Technology Resources

AP-3511.2 Peer to Peer Filing Sharing Procedures

AP-3511.3 Privacy and Release of Information

AP-3511.4 Identity Theft Prevention

AP-3511.5 Electronic Messaging

In addition, the Institutional Research and Analytics department of Northeast Community College adheres to the Association for Institutional Research (AIR) Statement of Ethics which is part of the department's Annual Plan.

- b) Verification of all legal notices received by the College during the reporting period confirmed that no notices were received from:
 - i. The Department of Education for a FERPA violation;
 - ii. The Office of Civil Rights for a HIPAA violation;
 - iii. The Federal Trade Commission for non-compliance with the GLBA; or
 - iv. The Payment Card Industry Security Standards Council for non-compliance PCI-DDS standards.

...the President shall not:

3. Cause or allow operations and handling that does not adhere to the ethical treatment of animals.

INTERPRETATION

Compliance will be demonstrated when:

- a) There are no negative findings by the accrediting body of the College Vet Tech program regarding the ethical treatment of animals. This is reasonable because part of the accrediting agency's responsibility is to determine the program falls within the agency's accreditation standards regarding the treatment of animals.
- b) No reports of mishandling of animals were made by any individuals receiving services from the College Vet Tech program. This is reasonable because reports of mishandling of animals is an indication of whether the animals are being ethically treated.

EVIDENCE

- a) The College Vet Tech program passed their accreditation process in 2024, and verification with the Director of the Vet Tech program, found there were no negative findings regarding the ethical treatment of animals in the report from the accrediting agency.
- b) The College Vet Tech program follows the <u>Northeast Community College Veterinary Technology Program IACUC Approved</u>
 Animal Use Protocols and Northeast Community College Veterinary Technology Animal Care Program. Verification with the

Director of the Vet Tech program confirmed there were no reports of mishandling of animals during the reporting period.

...the President shall not:

4. Cause or allow research that does not adhere to generally accepted ethical principles or been subject to independent ethical review.

INTERPRETATION

Compliance will be demonstrated when all research projects involving human subjects are reviewed by an Institutional Review Board (IRB) and only those projects approved by the IRB are allowed to proceed. This is reasonable because an IRB is a group required under FDA regulations that has been formally designated to review and monitor biomedical research involving human subjects. The purpose of an IRB is to ensure that appropriate steps are taken to protect the rights and welfare of humans participating as subjects in the research.

EVIDENCE

The College does not regularly engage in research projects on humans which require independent ethical review by an Institutional Review Board (IRB). In the event such a research project was contemplated, Northeast would enter into a written agreement with an institution with an Institutional Review Board, such as the State College system or the University of Nebraska system, to ensure compliance with all FDA regulations and the protection of human rights. In the past year, two projects were submitted for review and approval using the guidelines found in the Northeast Community College Faculty Handbook, page 44. The College has a working draft of a new procedure that will be presented to the Educational Services Standing Committee in September, 2024.

4. BOARD EDUCATION AND INFORMATION

4.1 Educational Services Report

4.1.1 Administrative Professional program review

A comprehensive review of the Administrative Professional program at Northeast Community College was provided. In Fall 2021, significant changes were made to the Administrative Professional program to create a better mix of business and computer applications. Discussions were held with the Advisory Committee members to make the improvements to design a student to be a true business partner.

To maximize resources and through continuous improvement, changes have been made in the program to create better pathways for students and to also create an employee that businesses want. In Fall 2023, technology courses were streamlined to make better use of resources on campus and to focus on better pathways for students so they can better build their schedules.

Faculty recommendation is to discontinue the Administrative Professional Associate of Applied Science degree but to continue the Administrative Professional certificate, Computer Application Specialist certificate, and the Administrative Professional diploma under the umbrella of the Business program at Northeast Community College. This will allow students opportunities to complete a short-term program that ladders into associate degree programs. These changes provide more visibility of the Computer Application Specialist certificate

to students in the Business programs seeking to enhance their computer skills and offer greater awareness of career opportunities within a business environment.

Data and charts within the Administrative Professional Comprehensive Program/Discipline Review document were reviewed, providing a basis for recommendation for board action.

4.1.2 Media Arts program review

Several years ago, faculty updated the curriculum so that students would take a common first year of courses and in the second year the students would move into the concentration of their choice. In Spring 2024, faculty presented a new curriculum to the Educational Services Standing Committee that eliminates the separate concentrations and offers a single-track media arts degree program. The revised curriculum includes a variety of experiences to prepare students for the multitude of skills needed across the different planforms in industry.

Data and charts within the Media Arts (All Concentrations) Comprehensive Program/Discipline Review document were reviewed, providing a basis for recommendation for board action.

7. BOARD EDUCATION AND INFORMATION

7.2 Development/External Relations Report

7.2.1 NCCA Report

- The NCCA Board of Directors met on May 6th at which time they discussed the 2025 budget. The NCCA budget is increasing 5.5% over last year and will be approved in August.
- The financial audit was also approved with no findings.
- The By-Law and Policy Committee presented their ideas regarding amending the by-laws. A lot of arduous work was involved with updating the by-laws.
- No major changes were recommended to the content of the procedures. Some stipulations were approved that require an institution that is planning to withdraw from NCCA to follow a specific timeframe. This is a recommendation that came forth from the audit.
- The third quarter meeting of the NCCA Board of Directors will be held in Lincoln on August 12, 2024.

7.2.2 Quarterly Foundation Board of Directors update

- Foundation Board of Directors met on April 30, 2024.
- The Weller Foundation scholarships were reviewed and approved. The majority of the scholarship recipients (38 out of 69) are Northeast Community College students.
- The Foundation Board is currently seeking nominations. The Foundation enjoys a long history of dedicated Board members who believe in the mission of the College and its work to support the success of its students and our region. Names of potential nominees should be provided to Tracy Kruse.
- Terms for seven members of the Foundation Board of Directors expire in 2024; however, five of those members have already agreed to extend their service for another term.
- The Scholarship Luncheon was held on April 30, 2024. The event was a success and is always a wonderful opportunity for students, donors, and the Board members to meet and discuss the students' educational goals and plans.

7.2.3 Monthly Presidential Update

Professional engagements during the past month include attending the NCCA Board of Directors meeting, represented Northeast during the recent UNL groundbreaking event for their USDA facility, and will serve as the NSWERS Executive Council president, effective July 1, 2024.

Acknowledged that many of the board members received a letter regarding the music tour. This is being worked on operationally, as has been occurring in the past several weeks. We see the opportunity for students to have more engagement throughout the year or during Spring break and not just at the end of the academic year. Faculty and staff had previously reached out to students and will continue to reach out to them to continue the dialogue.

Dr. Barrett reported that due to the delays in the release of FAFSA forms, only 38% of applicants have submitted their FAFSA as compared to 56% at the same time one year ago.

- The Governance Committee reviewed multiple policies for deletion and ensures that deleted policies are covered by another policy or in administrative procedure. These policies are included in today's decision portion of the agenda.
- Scott Gray completed a Governance Coach Assessing Monitoring Reports online self-guided course. Information received will be beneficial for training of new board members or as a refresher for all board members during a retreat. The Governance Committee will continue to review and evaluate the information to determine how it would be best shared with the Board of Governors.

10. MONITORING REPORT

10.1 EL-01, Treatment of Students

Every four years, Northeast administers the Ruffalo-Noel-Levitz Student Satisfaction Inventory (RNL-SSI), allowing students to share how satisfied they are with their student experience as well as issues that are important to them. Northeast's results are compared to a cohort to colleges of comparable size, geography, culture, etc. In 2024, another national survey was administered; however, those results are not yet available but will be included in the 2025 monitoring report.

Operational procedures are in place that outline the rules and expectations of employees, students, and campus visitors. All employees are made aware of the policies and operational procedures. Students are informed of policies and operational procedures during New Student Registration sessions, New Student Orientation, Residential Life Orientation, and through an email is sent to their Northeast email address during their first term of enrollment with a link to Notice to Enrolled Students. This Notice, as required by the Higher Education Act, is being sent to any new students enrolling throughout the academic year. Additionally, certain academic programs have academic program handbooks that outline academic and conduct expectations for students in their programs.

As a result of last year's monitoring report, in Spring 2024 a link to the Student Complaint Process was added to the Student Support Section of all course syllabi. Students are informed about filing complaints through the Student Code of Conduct which is provided to students during the first term of enrollment each academic year. The student grievance process is also clearly articulated as the next step in the student complaint process if students are not satisfied with the outcomes of their complaint. If a complaint is received outside of the established Student Complaint Process, Northeast has the responsibility to deal with that complaint to assure that we do not have a systematic problem within our system.

Love What They Do – A reputation of looking to always do their best for Northeast helps to distinguish Board Member Dirk Petersen and Early Childhood Instructor Lisa Guenther. Both have been nominated for awards in the Association of Community College Trustees' (ACCT) Western Region, which will be announced this summer.

Graphic Design – Luis Nolasco, who was among the May graduates with an associate in arts in graphic design, has always been the creative type. And that is one of the things that attracted him to Northeast's graphic design program. He plans to continue his education in the field, with a dream of eventually working in movies or cartoons. Until then, he will use the skills he acquired already for practical work. Nolasco also won gold last month in SkillsUSA in advertising design.

Promoting Reading – From her years of training, Lisa Guenther knows the importance of reading. That's one of the reasons she sought and obtained a grant from Dollar General that helps to put Joy of Reading kits in young people's hands. She recently traveled to several communities delivering the kits, which include a quality children's literature book and lesson ideas for parents, teachers and others to use with their youngsters.

President's/Dean's Lists – Northeast released the President's Honor List and Deans' Honor List for both full and part-time students for the Spring 2024 semester. To be named to the President's List, students must earn a grade point average of 4.0 and be enrolled for at least 12 credit hours. Students named to the Deans' List must have earned a grade point average of 3.75 or above and be enrolled for at least 12 credit hours. For both part-time lists, students must take at least six credit hours, with a 4.0 for the President's List and 3.75 for the Dean's List.

Big Red and Big Give — Big Red Restaurant and Sports Bar Manager Miranda Wieneke, who is a Northeast alumnus, helped to bring in some extra funds during the Norfolk Area Big Give. Big Red donated \$851 to support student success through a special promotion. The promotion provided a good opportunity for faculty, staff and board members to go out for lunch.

iHub Plans Remain – Almost as soon as some of the walls collapsed on the iHub building May 9, there was speculation the facility's future was in doubt. While it did throw off the timeline, it will be built. The general contractor has a plan to stabilize the remaining walls from collapse. Once the remaining walls are shored up and debris removed, work on the renovations will continue.

AWG is A.O.K. – Associated Wholesale Grovers is a strong supporter of the Northeast Food Pantry, consistently providing boxed meals, fresh produce, snacks, and more to students in need. For the 2023-24 academic year, there were 690 student visits to the food pantry. This was a significant increase compared to years past. That's one of the reasons why the AWG Cares grant request last month for \$3,000, designated for the student food pantry, was warmly received.

Houses Brings in Funds – One house brought \$210,00 and will be going to Plainview. Another brought \$190,000 and will head to Emerson. The student-built houses were auctioned June 1, in a tradition that dates to the 1980s. While this year's student-built house sale prices were down a bit from last year, the costs to construct them also were lower.





Nursing QIP Posters -- On April 29, the second-year nursing students presented their Quality Improvement Projects via a poster presentation. The posters were presented in the College of Nursing, with the public invited to view and ask questions. The team of students that won the award for their poster were Kelli Dannenbring, Kaylee Hinton, Falycia Krugman and Alyx Kurpgeweit. They worked with Valley Hope in O'Neill, with a project titled, "The Efficiency of Long-Acting Injectable Naltrexone versus Oral Naltrexone for Long Term Sobriety."

Dan Gillespie Remembered – The late Dan Gillespie, who farmed around the Battle Creek area, was one of the pioneers in minimum tillage. He also was the recipient of several awards committed to soil health during his lifetime. Thanks to the efforts of Jill Heemstra, Northeast director of the ag program, Northeast Community College's Student Agronomy Field Day has earned the support of the Dan Gillespie Soil Health Fund (DGSHF) in the form of a grant. Funds will further DGSHF's mission to support the agricultural leaders of the future and provide enhancements to the hands-on agriculture learning experience scheduled for late September 2024.

New Student Registration – New Student Registration (NSR) took place over the past two weeks at Northeast. NSR allows students who are planning to begin at Northeast during the fall semester to register for classes and meet with advisers, financial aid, and residence life representatives, among others. In addition, special parent and guest sessions were held to provide information about the many services available.

Pinning Ceremony – Associate degree nursing and practical nursing students were recognized during a special ceremony at Northeast with the presentation of their nursing pins and diplomas. In addition, the tradition of nursing students receiving their pins from family members or a close friend who have helped them along their journey was part of the ceremony.

Making Connections – Cyndi Hanson, dean of workforce development, attended the 69th annual Siouxland Chamber Delegation to Washington, D.C., in April. She was one of 46 individuals from the Siouxland tri-state area representing businesses, education, nonprofit and government entities, meeting with Congressional members and staff, among others. Workforce shortages and infrastructure needs were among the topics covered.

Latest and Greatest – Drew Dolezal, Northeast media arts instructor, and several of his students traveled to Las Vegas to attend the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) Convention in April. The Media Arts Club raised funds for the trip. The Las Vegas Convention Center, where NAB is held, is more than 2.5 million square feet where over 2,000 exhibitors demonstrate industry leading cameras, lighting equipment, broadcasting equipment, and software. Students get firsthand experience with new industry equipment and software, often not even released to the general population. Many students also use the opportunity to network with industry professionals.

Making Movies – Whether it is Quentin Tarantino, Martin Scorsese or Steven Spielberg, all movie directors and producers had to start somewhere. Drew Dolezal, Northeast media instructor, gives students in media arts the opportunity to write, direct and produce their own short films, which were shown recently at Norfolk 7 Theatre. Graduation Day – Consider it the Super Bowl of Northeast Community College. The 51st commencement of Northeast took place on Friday, May 10, in the Cox Activities Center on the Norfolk campus. Three commencement ceremonies were held.
