A report from President Leah Barrett included the following:

- Northeast's Nexus Project Campaign has received several large contributions in recent weeks.
- Northeast Community College has received \$1.7 million through the CARES Act, with a minimum of \$864,000 to be awarded in the form of emergency aid to students that will assist them with extra costs as a result of the campus closure and moving to remote learning due to

- the Coronavirus pandemic. As of July 14, Northeast has distributed \$570,444 to meet requests from students.
- Northeast Community College in Norfolk hosted the annual Big Bang Boom Independence Day fireworks extravaganza on Saturday, July 4<sup>th</sup>. Committee organizers asked Northeast for permission to hold the display on the Norfolk campus this year in order to abide by social distancing recommendations due to the COVID-19 pandemic while allowing for optimal viewing of the display across the city and surrounding area.
- A graduate of Northeast Community College, Dr. Jeremy Young of Elgin, has been installed as the president of the Nebraska Veterinary Medicine Association for 2020.
- The Educational Services Division held the first of three in-service sessions for more than 300 part-time and early college faculty members. The sessions are held to allow early college and adjunct faculty the opportunity to engage with their colleagues and become better prepared for new teaching experiences.
- Virtual new student registration continues throughout the summer. Northeast offered a virtual family forum session in June that featured a discussion with over 40 families of first-year students about the many support services available to help students achieve success.

Steve Anderson, NCCA Board of Directors representative, reported that their next meeting will be held in Lincoln on August 3<sup>rd</sup>. Approval of the NCCA 2020-2021 budget will be considered. Greg Adams continues to work on legislation at the local level. Early indications are that community college funding will not be impacted until January.

The ACCT board meeting in September will be held virtually.
