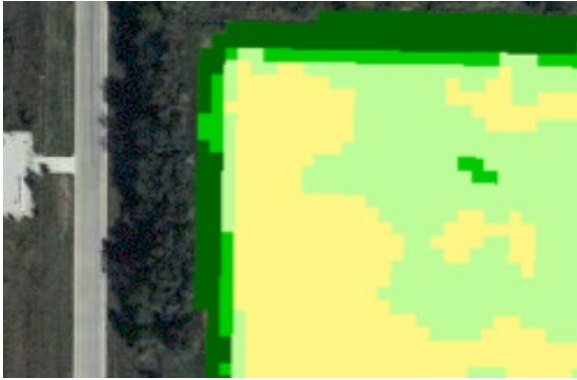
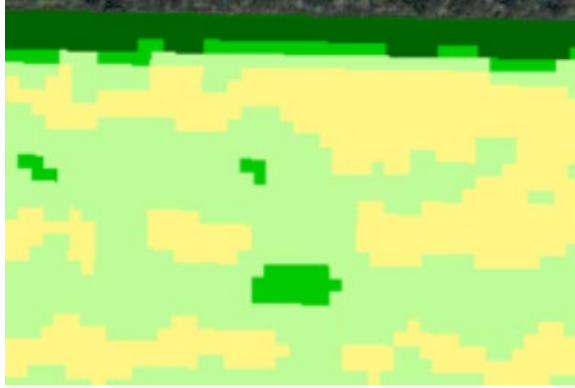




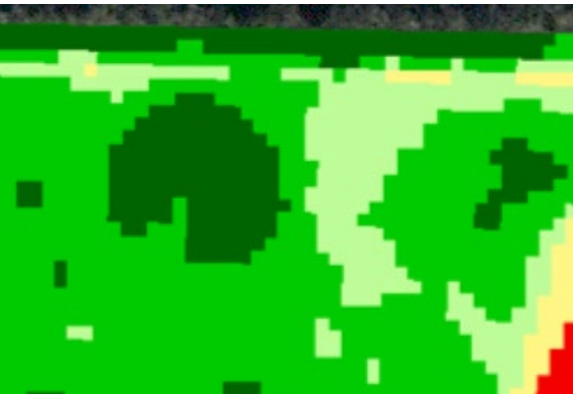
This puzzle has slight overlap with each of the pieces, to imitate stitching. If you print, you can cut these pieces out to give the students a field to stitch and diagnose issues with!

Tips: If you print multiple to have several puzzles, label the back of one puzzle all with the same letter or number so if they get mixed up you can easily reorganize them.

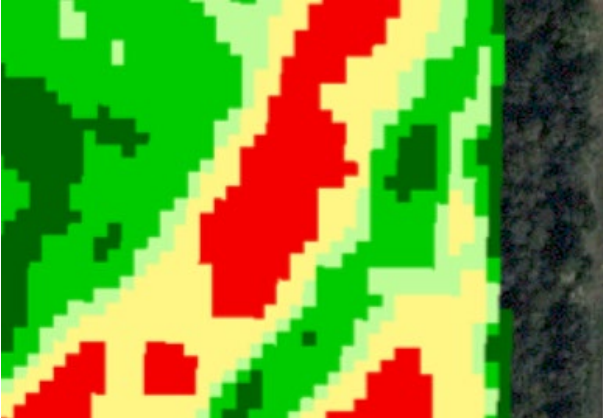
-There is an issue with one of the sprinklers in this field, which is why you see that red ring in the field. There does happen to be corn on one half of the field and beans on the other, which is why there is different colors on two halves of this puzzle. Some students may also notice the color difference and allude to the fact that there is a slight slope to this field, which is also true.



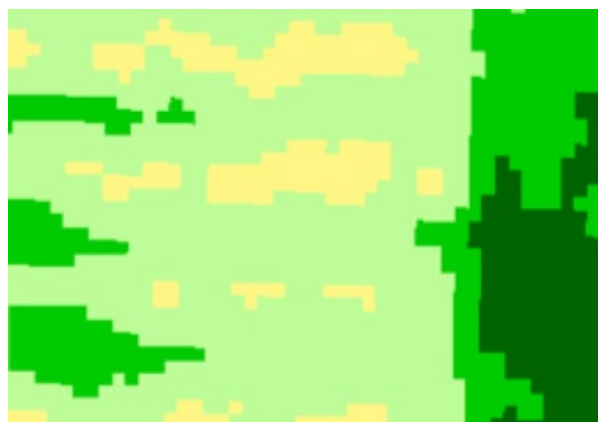


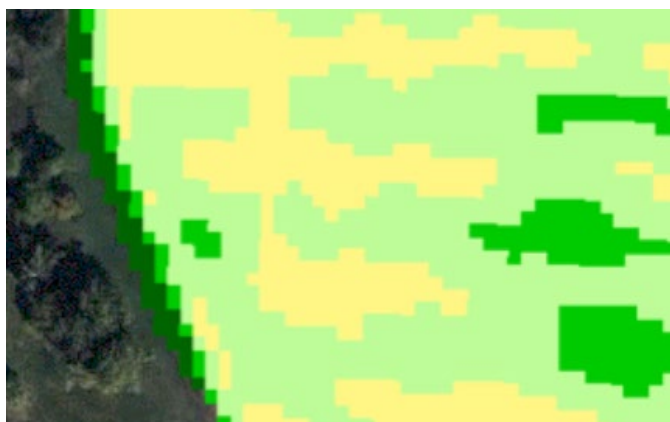


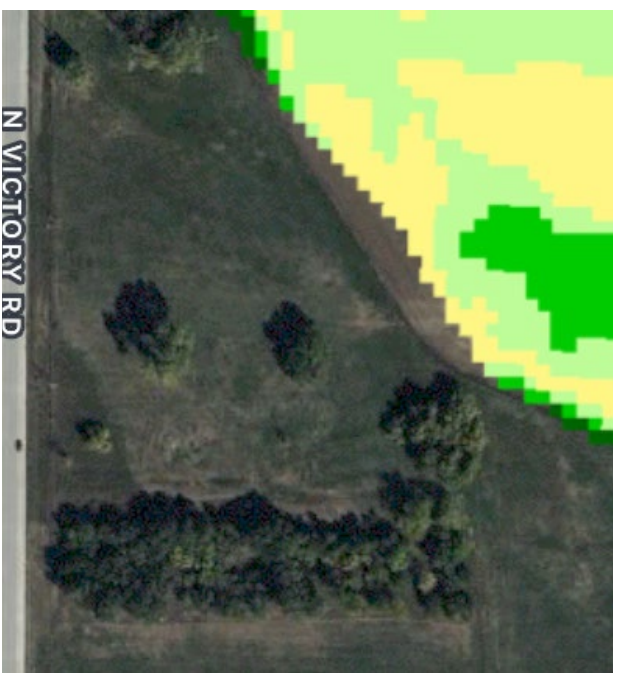


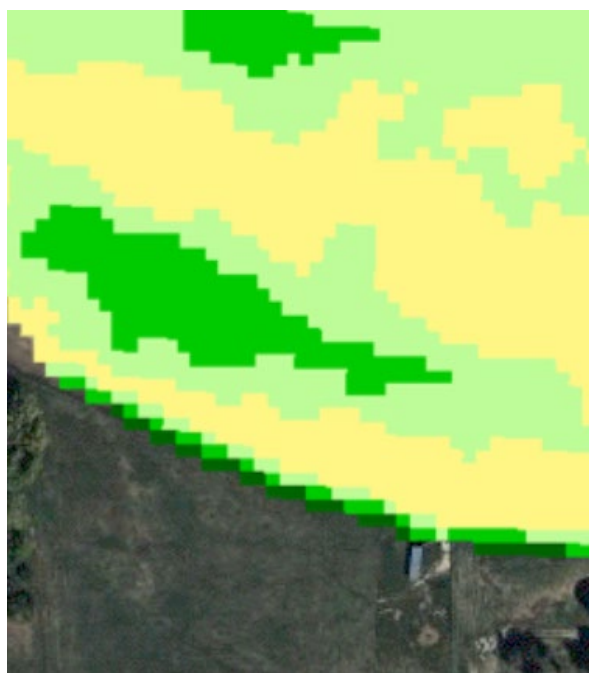
















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
